

MEETING GIRLS' NEEDS DURING COVID-19



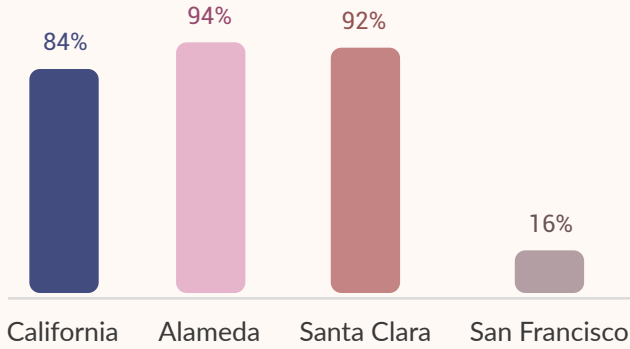
This data is compiled by Alliance for Girls' (AFG) youth research team. In March 2020, [this short survey](#) was developed for girls* in California up to age 24 for an ongoing data analysis at different time points of girls' experiences during the COVID-19 crisis. This current snapshot captures 807 responses from girls as of September 4, 2020. As AFG collects more data, it will present it with an intersectional analysis. As of September 2020, we have heard from 807 Girls*.

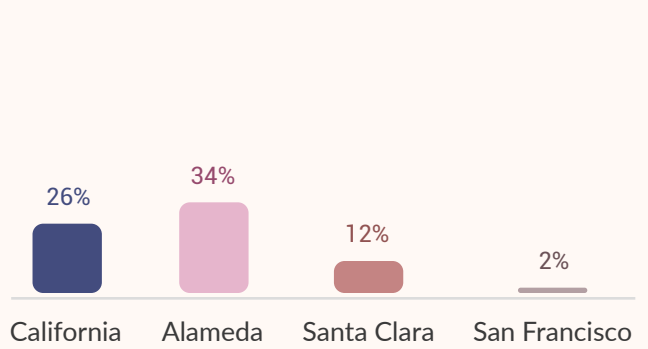
They described their gender identity as:

Their ages ranged from 5-24, with the average being 15.1 years.

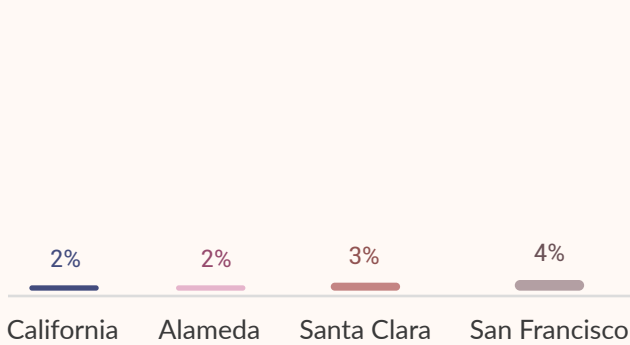

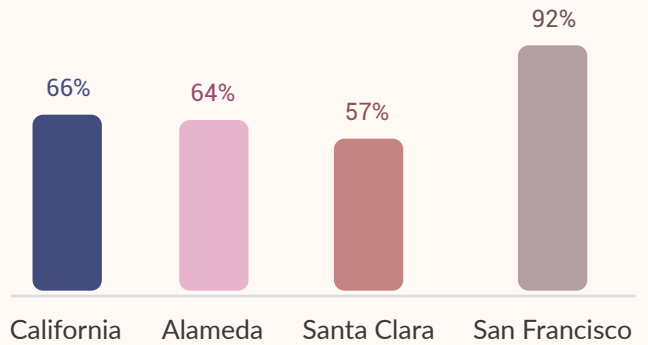

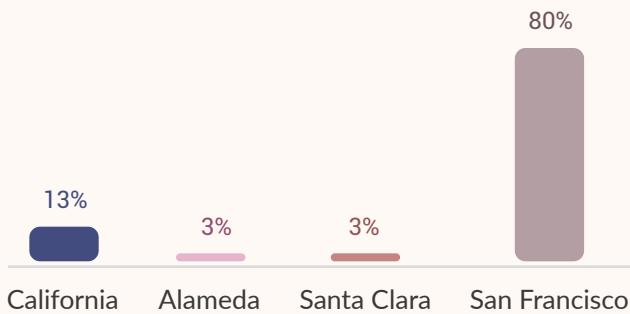

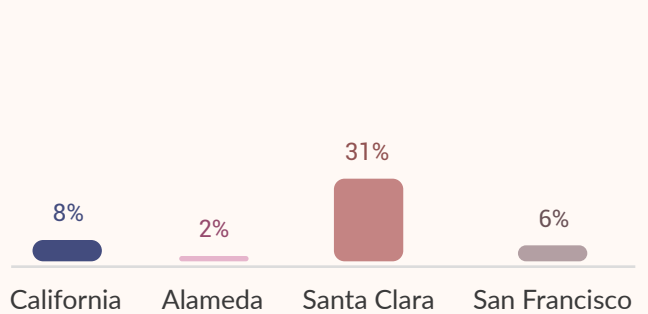

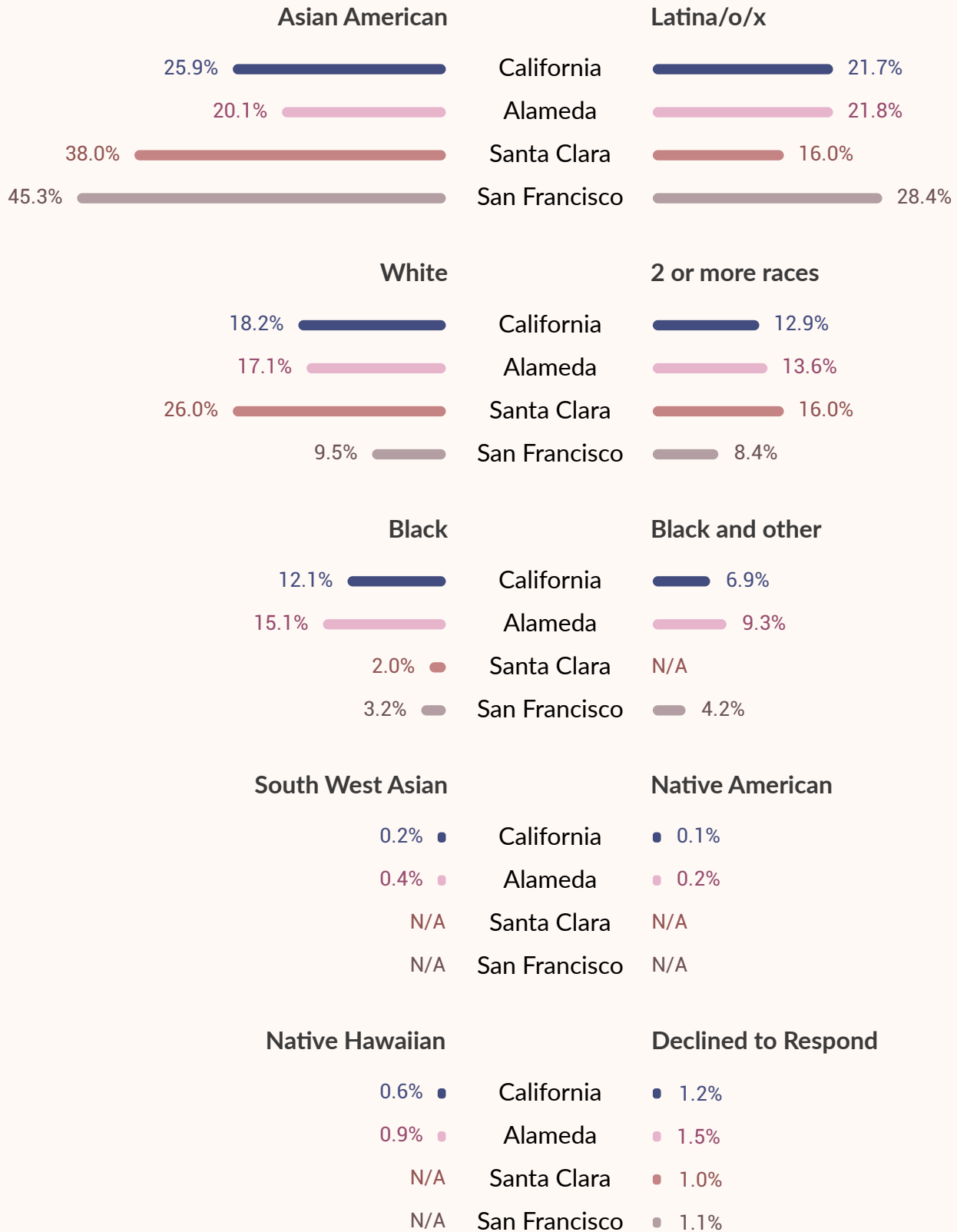

***For race/ethnicity breakdowns, the response ratio was calculated using the number of girls who were affected by the criteria in the specific race/ethnicity category divided by the number of girls in that category who answered the question."
